Desirable Attributes/Qualifications:

- 1. Working knowledge of modern sophisticated instruments including computer based instrumentation.
- 2. Managing and administering work of scientists and technicians.
- 3. Interest in science and technology education.

Other general conditions:

- (a) Minimum starting basic pay will be ₹43,000/- p.m. in the Pay Band IV of ₹ 37400 67000, with the applicable AGP of ₹10000 as per present U.G.C. regulations.
- (b) Higher starting pay may be given to the deserving candidate.
- (c) Probation period of one year.
- (d) After satisfactory completion of the probationary period, selected candidate will be eligible for post retirement benefits as per rules.
- (e) Age limit for applicant: Not exceeding 57 years as on 1st April 2013.
- (f) Applicants should clearly state in their applications particulars such as full name, address, date of birth, nationality, educational qualifications, experience, names and addresses of two referees and any other relevant information.
